Codes of Conduct

FC Shobuj Bangla is an ethnic football club and is proud to participate in the Finn Bangla football association scheme. We set the standards and best practice guides of achieving community development through football at all levels. We aim to ensure the highest standards of integrity and high reputation of the game by acting responsibly, above and beyond compliance with the law, those involved with the game at every level and whether as a player, match official, coach, founder or administrator/management. The codes of conduct apply to the following categories:

Community

- Football, at all levels

Equality

- Football is opposed to discrimination of any form

Trust and Respect

- Football will uphold a relationship of trust and respect between all involved in the game

Violence

- Football rejects the use of violence and abuse to others

Fairness

- Football is committed to fairness

Integrity and Fair Play

- Football is committed to Fair Play

Membership

- Membership is open to all individuals who support the aims and values of the club.
- Members must abide by the Club's Constitution, Code of Conduct, and pay relevant fees.
- Membership may be revoked by the management committee in cases of serious misconduct or non-compliance with club rules.



CODES OF CONDUCT FOR PLAYERS/MEMBERS

- Players are the most important people in the sport.
- Playing for the team, and for the team to win, is the most fundamental part of the game.
- ! But not winning at any cost - Fair Play and respect for all others in the game is fundamentally important.

These Codes focus on players/members involved in football at all levels.

Obligations towards the game

A player/member should:

1. Make every effort to follow team rules and the established codes of conduct.
2. Always show loyalty to the team, demonstrating respect and dedication in both attitude and actions.
3. Abide by the decisions made by the team management in the best interest of the game.
4. Actively maintain membership by making every effort to pay the monthly fee of €10 by the 15th of each month (except in justified circumstances).
5. Actively participate in training sessions — both summer and indoor — as well as in competitive tournaments, general meetings and different get-together events (except in justified circumstances).
6. Understand that not all players may be selected for tournaments; the best 15 will represent the team in competitive games. A second team may be formed based on group consensus, if necessary.
7. Make every effort to develop their own sporting abilities, in terms of skill, technique, tactics and stamina.
8. Give maximum effort and strive for the best possible performance during a game, even if their team is in a position where the desired result has already been achieved.
9. Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.
10. Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and time-wasting.
11. Always have regard for the best interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
12. Not use inappropriate language or misbehaviour during training as well as competitive game.
13. Always act with the best interest of game in mind.
14. Support the team in all time, irrespective of results of the game.
15. Sponsors will be treated as honorary members of the club in recognition of their support and shall be shown due respect and appreciation and may be invited to participate in various club activities and events.



Obligations towards one's team

A player/member should:

1. Make every effort consistent with Fair Play and the Laws of the Game to help their own team win.
2. Resist any influence which might, or might be seen to, bring into question their commitment to the team winning.

Respect for the Laws of the Game and competition rules

A player/member should:

1. Know and abide by the Laws, rules and spirit of the game, and the competition rules.
2. Accept success and failure, victory and defeat, equally.
3. Resist any temptation to take banned substances or use banned techniques.

Respect towards opponents

A player/member should:

1. Treat opponents with due respect always, irrespective of the result of the game.
2. Safeguard the physical fitness of opponents, avoid violence and rough play, and help injured opponents.
3. Applaud the opposition as well as own team, e.g. participate in post-match handshakes.

Respect towards the Match Officials

A player/member should:

1. Accept the decision of the Match Official without protest.
2. Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official.
3. Show due respect towards Match Officials.

Respect towards Team Management/Officials

A player/member should:

1. Abide by the instructions of their Team Management/Officials, provided they do not contradict the spirit of this Code.
2. Show due respect towards the Team Officials of the opposition.

Obligations towards the Supporters

A player/member should:

1. Show due respect to the interests of supporters.



CODES OF CONDUCT FOR TEAM MANAGEMENT & VOLUNTEERS

These Codes apply to all members of team management/club officials.

Obligations towards the Game

The team management/official should:

1. Ensure that all decisions are made with the best interests of the game in mind.
2. Make decisions collaboratively through transparent and open communication with all members of management.
3. Share relevant decisions with the wider group to maintain unity and transparency.
4. Set a positive example for others, particularly young players and supporters.
5. Support the development of the team while considering the interests of players, supporters, and the overall reputation of the game.
6. Share knowledge and experience when invited to do so, considering the interest of the body that has requested this rather than personal interests.
7. Ensure proper planning and organization for tournaments and team participation.
8. Approach critical or challenging situations with fairness, integrity, and calm judgment.
9. Avoid all forms of gamesmanship and uphold the spirit of the game.
10. Show due respect to Match Officials and others involved in the game.
11. Be mindful when publicly expressing opinions about any aspect of the game or individuals involved, always acting in the sport's best interest.
12. Not use or tolerate inappropriate language and show due respect to everyone involved.
13. Take responsibility for collecting funds, managing finances or securing sponsorships to support the team.

Obligations towards the Team

The team management/official should:

1. Make every effort to develop the sporting, technical and tactical levels of the club/team, and to obtain the best results for the team, using all permitted means.
2. Give priority to the interests of the team over individual interests.
3. Resist all illegal or unsporting influences, including banned substances and techniques.
4. Promote ethical principles.
5. Show due respect for the interests of the players, coaches and officials, their own club/team and others.



Obligations towards the Supporters

The team official should:

1. Show due respect for the interests of supporters.

Respect towards the Match Officials

A team official should:

1. Accept the decisions of the Match Official without protest.
2. Avoid words or actions which may mislead a Match Official.
3. Show due respect towards Match Officials.

CODES OF CONDUCT FOR SPECTATORS

Obligations towards the game

Supporters should:

1. Show due respect to match officials and others involved in the game.
2. Always have regard to the best interests of the game, including where publicly expressing an opinion on the game and any particular aspect of it, including others involved in the game.
3. Applaud the opposition as well as your own team.
4. Not use inappropriate language.

Respect towards the Match Officials

Supporters should:

1. Respect the decision of the Match Official.
2. Avoid words or actions, which may mislead a Match Official.
